



After-School Enrichment Program 2026

February 11th - March 5th

Dear Parents and Guardians:

Once again, the Delaware Township School Partners in Education (DTS PiE) is offering after-school enrichment classes this Winter. **The program will run on Wednesdays & Thursdays for four weeks beginning on February 11th & 12th & run until March 4th & 5th.**

The Enrichment program costs about \$8,000 to run, is open to all students grades K-8th at DTS & over 300 students participate each year. If you haven't already paid your 2025-2026 Program Fee at the start of the year, we suggest a payment of \$75/child to help offset costs. We will welcome all children, regardless of your ability to pay. If your child(ren) want(s) to participate & you are not in a position to pay, please register anyway.

We will continue to utilize ***Signup Genius*** for registration. The link will be posted on our website (www.dtspie.com) as well as our Facebook & IG Pages. Registration will go live at **10:00 am on January 24th & will remain open until January 31st**. If you are unable to register via the internet, please e-mail us at dtspie@gmail.com. Since registration is online, there will be no communication confirming the class your child is enrolled in so please make sure you note it at the time of registration. **No early sign-ups allowed, sign-ups happening before 10 am on 1/24 will be deleted!**

Class sizes are limited, please enroll your child for no more than one class per day; if you are enrolling multiple children, please enter them individually & do not group families together as we need the children's information during registration (e.g. grade, HR teacher, etc.). If we see children are enrolled in more than one class per day, we will delete their enrollment. Please be mindful to enroll your child in a class that conforms to the class description as far as grade guidelines; if children are enrolled for a class that is outside their grade, we will delete their enrollment as well.

Children are expected to follow the behavior standards required during the school day. Classes begin immediately after school & end at 4:30 pm. Dismissal will be in the school cafeteria. Per school rules, any child in 4th grade and younger must be signed out by a parent or guardian; as parent volunteers, we do not have the same ability to oversee safety in the parking lots, therefore, we appreciate in advance conforming to these rules of an adult signing out children in 4th grade or younger. Additionally, please make sure to send in a note indicating your child is staying after school for each day & each week of Enrichment. Students without a note will be dismissed per their typical arrangements (e.g. sent home on the bus).

The Enrichment Program is run by volunteers & cannot continue without your help. Parent volunteers are needed to assist the instructors & help with logistics. If your child/ children will be participating in a program, please consider signing up as a volunteer through a separate Sign-up Genius that will also be posted on our webpage. The attached form includes a description of each course & a payment form. Please note all classes are limited in size & to specific age groups.
